## Clery Incident Classification

**Murder/Non-Negligent Manslaughter**— The willful (non-negligent) killing of a human being by another.

**Negligent Manslaughter**— The killing of another person through gross negligence

**Sex Offense, Forcible**— Rape, sodomy, sexual fondling or sexual assault with an object/

**Sex Offense, Non-Forcible**— Statutory rape (victim under the legal age of consent) or consensual incest.

**Robbery**— Taking/attempting to take something by force, violence, threat, or by putting victim in fear

**Aggravated Assault**—Unlawful attack upon another with intent to inflict severe injury or great bodily harm

**Motor Vehicle Theft**— Theft of automobiles, etc, including “joy riding” with unlawful access

**Arson**—Willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn a structure, vehicle or property

**Arrest: Weapons** (Carrying, Possession, etc.)

**Disciplinary Referral** (Weapons)

**Arrest: Drug Abuse Violation**

**Disciplinary Referral** (Drug abuse violation)

**Arrests: Liquor Law Violation**

**Disciplinary Referral** (Liquor Law)

## Bias or Hate Crimes (only if crime motivated by hate or bias)

**Larceny– Theft**— The unlawful taking, carrying, leading or riding away of property from the possession of another.

**Simple Assault**— An unlawful physical attack by one person upon another where no weapons are used.

**Intimidation**— To unlawfully place another person in reasonable fear of bodily harm through the use of threatening words and/or conduct.

**Destruction/Damage/Vandalism of Property**

## VAWA Crimes

**Dating Violence**— Violence between individuals who have or have had a continuing and significant relationship of a romantic or intimate nature. The relationship must have been within the past 6 months; characterized by the expectation of affection or sexual involvement between the two parties; and the involvement occurred over time and on a continuous basis throughout the relationship.

**Domestic Violence**—Any assault, aggravated assault, batter, aggravated batter, sexual assault, sexual battery, stalking, aggravated stalking, kidnapping, false imprisonment, or any criminal offense resulting in physical injury or death of one family or household member by another family or household member.

**Stalking**—Willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follows, harasses or cyberstalks another person
